# 7.68.0 New Features



This guide lists new features available in **eTapestry** 7.68.0, released on October 10, 2021.

## **Blackbaud Checkout.** PayPal and Venmo

**Note:** As *Venmo* is a mobile payment service owned by *PayPal*, *Venmo* transactions are marked in **eTapestry** as *PayPal* transactions.

*PayPal* and *Venmo* are now available as payment methods for one-time transactions in **Blackbaud Checkout** for users with a **Blackbaud Merchant Services** account. To enable these payments, set up *PayPal* integration in **Blackbaud Checkout** by following the steps in the [PayPal Integration Setup Guide](#).

*PayPal* and *Venmo* payment methods are currently available for DIY Forms and eStore/Cart only. You can also manually enter a gift with *PayPal* or *Venmo* information; however, the ability to process these payments when you enter a gift is not available.

**Note:** You will need to troubleshoot or reconcile *PayPal* and *Venmo* transactions through your *PayPal* and *Venmo* business accounts. Transaction information is not available in the **Blackbaud Merchant Services** web portal.

Before you can accept *PayPal* or *Venmo* donations, you must first connect your *PayPal* to your **Blackbaud Merchant Services** account.

### **DIY Forms**

You can create and publish your own Do It Yourself (DIY) Online Forms to use for online giving, event registrations, membership, and more. After users select **Submit** when they fill out online giving, event registration, or membership forms, **Blackbaud Checkout** prompts them to securely finalize payment details. *PayPal* or *Venmo* are now supported and display in **Blackbaud Checkout** if your merchant account is enrolled with *PayPal*.

### **eStore (Cart)**

The eStore module allows you to directly manage the content of your eStore pages from **eTapestry** so you can sell items on your website directly to your constituents and integrate the payment information with your database. After donors select **Process Order** during checkout, **Blackbaud Checkout** takes them to securely finalize payment details. Users will now be able to select to pay with their *PayPal* or *Venmo* account.

### **Manual Gift Entry**

When you enter information for single gift made with *PayPal* or *Venmo*, you can mark the gift as a *PayPal* transaction. On the New Gift/Pledge screen, under **Gift Types**, select **Payment Service**. Under **Vendor**, *PayPal* is automatically selected.

## Transaction Processors: 3-D Secure

eTapestry now supports 3-D Secure for the *Blackbaud Merchant Services*, CyberSource, and IATS-UK gateways. From **Management, My Organization**, select **eCommerce**.

Select to create a new *BBMS*, CyberSource, or IATS-UK gateway or edit an existing one. Under the transaction processor options, select **Use 3DS**.

## Transaction Processors: Test Mode

You can now test payments on Cart and DIY Pages that use *Blackbaud Merchant Services* transaction processors.

To test payments on these forms, from **Management, My Organization**, select **eCommerce**. Select to create a new *BBMS* transaction processor or edit an existing one. Under the transaction processor options, select Test in the **Processor Mode** drop down and save your changes. Now, you can enter test credit card information in **Blackbaud Checkout** to test the form. To submit test information to **Blackbaud Checkout**, see [How do I test an online donation page](#).

**Warning:** After you complete testing, be sure to change the processor mode back to live to be sure that real gifts are not rejected.

## Journal Entries: Attachment File Size

You can add an attachment to a journal entry, such as an image. Journal entries that allow attachments include gifts, pledges, pledge payments, disbursements, recurring gifts, contacts, and notes. Previously, **eTapestry** limited the attachment sizes for journal entries to 10 MB. With this release, you can now upload files up to 15 MB.
